2 03-07-2026 Though nobody has bothered to appear for the petitioner, however this Court finds that no positive direction has been issued by this Court, vide order dated 21.09.2024, passed in CWJC No. 14323 of 2024, nonetheless the opposite parties have inquired into the matter and filed a show cause from which it is apparent that the land in question is not a public land but an ancestral joint property of the concerned private owner, hence the proceedings have been closed, vide order dated 9.5.2024 and the complaint



of the petitioner has been consigned.

2. This Court is satisfied that the order of this Court dated 21.09.2024, passed in CWJC No. 14323 of 2024 has stood complied with, hence the present contempt petition stands dismissed.
