3 01-05-2026 Perused the Letter No. 213 dated 09.02.2026 of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bhagalpur along with the Report dated 07.02.2026 of the Police Inspector-cum-S.H.O, Goradih Police Station, Bhagalpur, wherein it is indicated that during enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Sunder Yadav, is dead.

2. In view of the said letter as also Section 394 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, which corresponds to Section 435 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, since no near relative has filed any application for leave to
