2. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the entire criminal proceeding arising out of Prosecution report no. 14C2/2011 filed by the Labour Enforcement Officer (Central) for the offences punishable under Section 6 of Equal Remuneration Act, 1976 and order dated 10.01.2011 passed by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nalanda by which cognizance was taken against the petitioner under Section 6 of Equal Remuneration Act, 1976 and also directed for issuance of summon.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this



case has become infructuous, accordingly, the same may be disposed of.
