3 13-03-2026 Perused the Letter No. 436 dated 13.02.2026 of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patna, along with report dated 09.02.2026 of the Police Inspector-cum-S.H.O., Parsa Bazar Police Station, Patna, wherein it is indicated that during the enquiry it came to light that the sole appellant, namely, Kamta Prasad Verma, is dead and the death certificate of the appellant is annexed with the said report.
