Counsel for the opposite parties submits that in compliance of the order of this Court dated 26.04.2023, passed in CWJC No. 4988 of 2023, all the encroachers except five have been removed and as far as the remaining five encroachers are concerned, they have been allotted land under their occupation by virtue of the provisions contained in the Bihar Privileged



Persons Homestead Tenancy Act, 1948.

2. In view of the aforesaid, the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to take recourse to such remedies as are otherwise available under the law for redressal of his subsisting grievance. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
