2. It has been jointly submitted by the counsel of all
the cases that in compliance of order dated 28.02.2024, a
decision has been taken by the Director-in-Chief, Health
Services, Government of Bihar, New Secretariat, Patna, which
has been served upon counsel of first case C.W.J.C. No.3830 of
2024 through supplementary show-cause vide annexure-A and
the copy of the order contained in Memo No.188 dated
11.03.2026 has been served to the petitioners of first case and a
copy of order contained in Memo No.189 dated 11.03.2026 has
