ORAL ORDER

3 13-03-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
APP for the State and perused the case diary.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Purnea
Cyber P.S. Case No. 64 of 2025, instituted for the offences
punishable under Section 95 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita,
2023, read with Sections 67, 67(A), 67(B) of the I.T. Act,
Sections 15(1) and 15(2) of the POCSO Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the police
intercepted the petitioner and recovered a mobile phone
containing videos and photos of child pornography.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
present case. Charge-sheet has been submitted in this case and
charge has also been framed against the petitioner. No



incriminating material has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that neither the alleged mobile phone nor the e-mail id belong to the petitioner. No specific allegation has been attributed against the petitioner rather the same is general and omnibus in nature. The petitioner is in custody since 27.08.2025 and has got no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and taking into account the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Purnea Cyber P.S. Case No. 64 of 2025, subject to the following conditions:

(I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.

(II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two



consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to cancel the
bail bonds of the petitioner.
