Bihar, Patna i.e. Respondent No. 2 herein, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to the Respondent No. 2 to consider the said representation and pass necessary orders in accordance with law. The authority before passing any order shall put the petitioner on notice and give him an opportunity of hearing. The authority shall endeavour to dispose of the said representations as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 8 weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order. Any decision taken by the authority shall be communicated to the party.

3. With the above directions, the present Writ Petition stands disposed of.
