2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition to pursue appropriate legal remedies before the “competent authority.”

3. Learned counsel for the State raises no objection to the prayer so made.



4. Accordingly, the writ petition stands dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty to the petitioner to approach the competent authority. It is clarified that the competent authority/court shall consider and decide the issue of limitation independently, in accordance with law, and shall duly factor the time spent during the pendency of the present writ petition before this Court.
