4 10-03-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned counsel for the informant and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Ahiyapur P.S. Case No. 540 of 2025 registered for the offence under Sections 126(2), 118(2), 109, 118(1) and 3(5) of the B.N.S.

3. As per the prosecution case, petitioners are alleged to have burnt the victim.

4. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are innocent and they have falsely been implicated in this case. It is next submitted that the the victim has sustained the burn injury himself and



subsequently accused the petitioners in the said case. Petitioners have clean antecedent.

5. Learned counsel for the informant as well as learned A.P.P. for the State jointly opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts, this application is allowed.

7. Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the concerned Court below within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Muzaffarpur/ concerned Court below in connection with Ahiyapur P.S. Case No. 540 of 2025, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 / Section 482 of the BNSS.
