the petitioner and Mr. Brajendra Nath Pandey, learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail, who is in custody since
01.07.2025 in connection with Barahat P.S. Case No. 91 of
2023, F.I.R. dated 02.05.2023 for the offences punishable under
Sections 420, 467, 468, 471/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. According to prosecution case, the informant
alleged that the petitioner along with other co-accused persons,
on the basis of forged documents, mutated the land of the
informant in the name of their mother late Mala Devi.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has clean antecedent and he has falsely been
implicated in the present case. The allegation as alleged in the
F.I.R. is false and fabricated and the petitioner has not



committed any offence as alleged in the F.I.R. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner along with his brother, namely, Upendra Singh has also been made accused in the present case on the same set of allegation and brother of the petitioner has been granted privilege of anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 17.11.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 75725 of 2025 and the police after investigation, submitted chargesheet against the petitioner and the petitioner is in custody since 01.07.2025.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, petitioner has clean antecedent and same set of allegation, co-accused person has been granted privilege of anticipatory bail by this Court, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M. 1st, Banka in connection with Barahat P.S. Case No. 91 of 2023, with the following conditions:

i. Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court and shall remain physically present as directed by the court and



on his absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his/her bail bond shall be cancelled by the Court below.

ii. If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses, in that case, the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.

iii. And further condition that the court below shall verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and in case at any stage it is found that the petitioner has concealed his criminal antecedent, the court below shall take step for cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner. However, the acceptance of bail bonds in terms of the above-mentioned order shall not be delayed for purpose of or in the name of verification.
