4 11-02-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Nawada P.S. Case No. 1386 of 2024 instituted for the offence
under Sections 178, 179 & 180 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita,
2023.

3. Prosecution case, in short, is that petitioner was
apprehended by the police and from his possession, 25
counterfeit Rs. 100 notes were recovered.

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner
that the petitioner is in custody since 24.11.2024. Petitioner
bears one criminal antecedent, as per disclosure made in
paragraph No. 3 of the bail application.



5. It has been further submitted by the petitioner's counsel that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has no concern with the recovered counterfeit currency. There is no compliance of Section 103 of the BNSS, 2023. Charge sheet has already been submitted in this case, whereafter, charge is also framed in this case.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, period of custody of the petitioner and charge being framed, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Nawada P.S. Case No. 1386 of 2024, subject to the following conditions:

(I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.

(II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two



consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to cancel the
bail bonds of the petitioner.
