Special P.P. Ms. Usha Kumari No.1.
2. In view of the grounds taken in the Limitation
application, delay of 111 days in filing the appeal is condoned,
as such I.A. No.1 of 2026 is allowed.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
appellant after arguing vehemently for some time, realizing his
difficulty, seeks permission to withdraw the appeal with liberty
to the appellant to surrender and seek regular bail.
4. Permission is accorded.
5. It is made clear that if appellant surrenders and
seeks regular bail, the learned trial court shall consider the case



on its own merit without being prejudiced by the fact that
appellant before his court withdrew his anticipatory bail
application.
