3 24-07-2026 The Ld. Counsel for the opposite parties submits that a bare perusal of paragraph no. 11 of the show cause filed in the



present case would show that the benefit of second M.A.C.P. in the pay-band of Rs. 5200-20200 with grade pay of Rs. 2000/- has been granted to the petitioners vide letter dated 03.02.2016 (annexed as Annexure-E to the show cause).

2. At this juncture, the Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that if the statement being made by the opposite parties is true, the present petition be disposed of, however reserving liberty in favour of the petitioners to approach the respondent authorities in case of any subsisting grievance. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
