At the outset, learned Senior Counsel submits that an order has been passed vide memo no. 568 dated 10.09.2025 by the Chief Executive Officer of the said Bihar State Mining Corporation Limited, Patna (Annexure-A to the supplementary show cause and in that background, the contempt petition can be dropped giving liberty to the petitioner to take appropriate steps in the matter.

4. In that background, granting liberty to the petitioner, the MJC No. 3517 of 2023 is disposed of.
