This petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 29.05.2018 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge-I, Kaimur (Bhabua) in Criminal Appeal No. 03 of 2018, whereby and whereunder the order dated 08.11.2017 passed by learned A.C.J.M.-VII, Kaimur (Bhabua) in Case No. 852 of 2016 in a proceeding under Prevention of Domestic Violence Act has been completely set aside, but petitioner is directed to pay Rs.5,000/- per month to O.P.
