Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The accused/petitioner seeks bail in connection
with Chiraiya P.S. Case No.520 of 2022 registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 392 of the Indian Penal
Code (in short 'IPC').

3. The accused/petitioner is not named in the FIR
and is in custody since 28.07.2025.

4. As per FIR, the unknown miscreants committed
robbery and while committing so, taken away a motorcycle
bearing Registration No. BR04AD-1374, mobile phone,
A.T.M. card and cash of Rs.6,000/- belongs to the informant.

5. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing for



petitioner that the name of this petitioner transpired during investigation on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Nitesh Kumar, in furtherance of which, no incriminating materials appears recovered/surfaced during investigation as to connect the petitioner with present crime in question. The petitioner was also not put on T.I.P. as yet. While concluding argument, it is submitted that investigation of this case is already completed, for which, charge-sheet has been submitted and, as such, there is no chances of tampering with the evidence.

6. Explaining criminal antecedent, it is submitted that petitioner found involved in one more criminal case, where he is on bail.

7. Learned APP opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

8. In view of aforesaid factual submissions and by taking note of fact as *prima facie* save and except suspicion arising out of confessional statement of co-accused, nothing appears incriminating during investigation against petitioner, who is in custody since 28.07.2025, coupled with the fact that



investigation of this case is already completed, accordingly, the petitioner, above-named, is directed to be released on bail furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Sikarahana at Dhaka, East Champaran, Motihari/concerned court in connection with Chiraiya P.S. Case No.520 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 437(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short ‘CrPC’)/under Section 480(3) of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (for short ‘BNSS’)
