and the State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in Dumra P. S. Case
No. 418 of 2025 registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 103(2), 61(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita nad
Section 27 of the Arms Act.

3. As per F.I.R., on 21.08.2025 at about 5:30 PM, all
the named accused persons, including this petitioner, along with
some unknown miscreants committed murder of the brother of
informant by firing gunshot, due to dispute over five *katha* land.
On 19.08.2025, all the accused persons threatened the deceased
to register the land in their favour.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that



petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. Though petitioner is named in the F.I.R. but neither his footage has been captured in the CCTV footage nor his name transpired in confessional statement of co-accused persons. Petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case merely on the basis of suspicion.

5. Learned counsel for the informant vehemently opposed the bail application and submitted that petitioner is named in the F.I.R. with specific accusation that he along with other accused persons killed his brother by firing gunshot.

6. Considering the nature and seriousness of accusation, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is refused.
