petitioner and Mr. Rajendra Singh, learned Additional Public

Prosecutor for the State.

2. Petitioner seeks bail who is in custody since
05.08.2025 in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No. 31 of 2025,
F.I.R. dated 04.08.2025 for the offences punishable under
Sections 329(4), 64(1), 64(2), (2-J), 62 and 78 of BNS, 2023.

3. According to prosecution case, this petitioner
outraged the modesty of the informant and also tried to commit
rape upon her.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has clean antecedent and he has falsely been
implicated in the present case. The allegation as alleged in the
F.I.R is false and fabricated and the petitioner has not committed



any offence as alleged in the F.I.R and due to office politics the petitioner has been made accused in the present case. It appears from the F.I.R itself that the petitioner has committed nothing wrong with the informant. As per the allegation, the informant claims that the petitioner tried to commit rape upon her and apart from that, the informant has refused for her medical examination. He further submits that the police after investigation submitted the charge sheet against the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 05.08.2025.

5. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances that the petitioner has clean antecedent, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned SDJM, Saharsa in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No. 31 of 2025, subject to the following conditions:-

i. Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court and shall remain physically present as directed by the court and on his absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient



reason, his bail bond shall be cancelled by the Court below.

ii. If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses, in that case, the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.

iii. And further condition that the court below shall verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and in case at any stage it is found that the petitioner has concealed his criminal antecedent, the court below shall take step for cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner. However, the acceptance of bail bonds in terms of the above-mentioned order shall not be delayed for purpose of or in the name of verification.
