3 31-01-2026 Heard Mr. Jainendra Kumar Pushkar learned counsel
for the petitioner and Ms. Madhuri Lata, learned APP for the
State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for bail in connection
with Rupaspur P.S. Case No. 605 of 2025 registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 8(c) and 21(b) of the
N.D.P.S. Act.

3. The case of the prosecution is that from the
possession of the petitioner, altogether 8 gram of smack like
substance was recovered.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has
committed no offence. Petitioner is a lady and she has been
falsely implicated in this case. She has no any concern with the
alleged recovered contraband. Learned counsel for the petitioner



has submitted that the witnesses of the seizure list are police personnel and police has not complied Section 105 of the BNSS. It has further been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that alleged recovery, if any, is though more than small quantity but is much less than commercial quantity. She is having no criminal antecedent and she is languishing in judicial custody since 27.09.2025.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the application for bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sessions Judge / Special Judge(N.D.P.S.), Patna in connection with Rupaspur P.S. Case No. 605 of 2025.
