2. This petition has been filed for quashing the
cognizance order dated 22.11.2017 passed by learned Sub-
Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Raxaul, Motihari in Criminal
Revision No. 182 of 2015.

3. *Vide* order dated 02.04.2026, a report regarding
present status of case was called for and the same was sent *vide*
Letter No. 422 dated 18.04.2026 by the learned Trial Court. As
