petitioner and learned APP appearing on behalf of the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends her arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 74, 352 and and 3(5) of the B.N.S..

3. As per prosecution case, it is alleged that this petitioner assaulted on the head of informant by means of bricks due to which her head ruptured.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. As a matter of fact, both parties are co-villagers and due to petty dispute enmity, this false and concocted case has been lodged. Doctor has found the injuries, sustained by the injured, simple in nature. Petitioner is a lady



and claims clean antecedents.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of injuries sustained by the injured and clean antecedents of the petitioner, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is allowed.

7. Accordingly, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Jehanabad in connection with Jehanabad P.S. Case No. 614 of 2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S..
