A.P.P. for the State.

2. Petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with  
Pipariya P. S. Case No. 60 of 2025 registered for the offences  
punishable under Sections 103(1)/61(2)(a)/3(5) of the Bharatiya  
Nyaya Sanhita and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, when the informant's  
husband was returning home after participating in the last rituals  
of the father of Ashok Singh, the co-accused persons along with  
5-7 unknown miscreants holding weapons fired indiscriminately  
upon the informant's husband and one Chandan Kumar due to  
which they died. On hearing the noise of firing, the informant,  
her brother along with villagers ran towards the spot and saw  
them firing while fleeing away.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. and his name has surfaced during the course of investigation of the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Rama Kant Singh. Co-accused Dhiraj Kumar confessed that he was contracted for killing for consideration amount of Rs. 5 lacs and thereafter he was accommodated at Mahadeo Cinema with this petitioner. It is further submitted that petitioner is not alleged to have participated in the alleged occurrence and for the same occurrence, two information were given to the police. One by the wife of deceased on 1.05.2025 and another by the brother of deceased, namely, Chandan Kumar on 19.06.2025 wherein he has mentioned that 6-7 unknown persons committed the murder. Allegation of assault is general and omnibus and there is no allegation of any specific overt act against the petitioner. Petitioner claims clean antecedent and is in custody since 28.7.2025. Charge-sheet has already been submitted.

5. However, learned A.P.P. for the State vehemently opposed the bail application.

6. Considering the nature of accusation, clean antecedent and period of custody, this bail application is allowed. The petitioner, above named, is directed to be released



on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lakhisarai/concerned Judicial Magistrate, 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Lakhisarai in connection with Pipariya P. S. Case No. 60 of 2025.
