2 06-01-2026 Heard Mr. Anish Kumar, learned counsel for the

petitioner and Mr. Pawan Kumar Chaurasia, learned APP for

the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for bail in connection
with Raniganj P.S. Case No. 349 of 2025 registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 8(c), 21(b) and 21(c) of the
NDPS Act.

3. The case of the prosecution in short is that from the
possession of this petitioner, altogether 147 gram of *smack* like
material was recovered.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has
committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this



case. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing has been recovered from the possession of this petitioner. The witnesses of the seizure list are police personnel. It is also submitted that the police have not complied with Section 105 of the BNSS while making the seizure. He further submits that the alleged recovery is though more than small quantity but is much less than commercial quantity. Moreover, the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 09.09.2025.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, NDPS Act, Araria in connection with Raniganj P.S. Case No. 349 of 2025.
