2 09-02-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offences punishable under Sections 103(2), 80, 238 and 3(5)
of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.

3. It is a case of dowry death. As per prosecution case,
informant alleged that marriage of his daughter was solemnized
with co-accused Saurabh Kumar on 12.06.2022 as per Hindu
rites and rituals and thereafter, all the F.I.R. named accused
persons, including this petitioner, committed torture and
harassment with the victim due to non-fulfillment of demand of
dowry and subsequently, on 10.06.2025, all the accused persons
committed murder of the victim and concealed the dead body in
a pit.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. Petitioner



is brother-in-law of the deceased and he is simply victim of over-implication. Allegation against petitioner is general and omnibus. Petitioner is separate in mess and property and has got no concern with family affairs of the deceased. He further submits that thrust of accusation is against husband of the deceased who is already in custody since 10.10.2025. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposed the bail application.

6. Considering the fact that husband of the deceased is already in custody, this anticipatory bail is allowed and it is ordered that let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jamui in connection with Jamui P.S. Case No. 319 of 2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482 (2) BNSS.
