A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for the offences under Sections 191(1), 190, 126(2), 127(2), 115(2), 118(2), 324(2), 103(1), 352, 351(2) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. As per the prosecution case, on 17.04.2025 at about 4 PM, while informant was at his door, all the accused persons named in the F.I.R., including this petitioner, came and assaulted informant and his brother. It is further alleged that co-accused Sharwan Rai assaulted on the head of brother of informant with iron rod, as a result of which, brother of informant died in course of treatment. This petitioner is alleged to have assaulted informant with *khanti*.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that



specific accusation of assault to the deceased is against co-accused Shrawan Rai. Petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case due to long standing land dispute between the parties. Though petitioner is alleged to have assaulted informant but there is no injury report on record to substantiate the allegation. It is further submitted that similarly situated co-accused, namely, Puja Devi has already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court *vide* order dated 11.11.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 75782 of 2025. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the above named petitioner, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Samastipur / concerned Court in connection with Dalsing Sarai P.S. Case No. 142 of 2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482 of the BNSS.
