4 30-03-2026 Heard Mr.Indrajit Kumar, learned counsel for the
petitioner and Mr.Lalan Kumar, learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail, who is in custody since
19.05.2025 in connection with S.Tr.No.281/2025 arising out of
Medni Chowki P.S. Case No. 71 of 2025, F.I.R. dated
19.05.2025 registered for the offence punishable under Sections
25(1-B)a/26/35 of the Arms Act.

3. The case relates to recovery of one loaded Desi
Pistol and two live cartridges from possession of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that from a bare perusal of the FIR it appears that one
loaded country made Pistol and two live cartridges were
recovered from possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel
for the petitioner submits that there is non-compliance of



Section 103 of BNSS 2023. Further submits that the co-accused person, namely, Punit Kumar has been granted bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Hon'ble Court vide order dated 15.12.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 84195 of 2025 and police, after investigation, submitted the chargesheet against the petitioner and the petitioner is in custody since 19.05.2025.

5. Learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner and submits that the petitioner carries eight more cases other than the present one, as mentioned in para-3 of the bail petition.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Lakhisarai in connection with S.Tr.No.281/2025 arising out of Medni Chowki P.S. Case No. 71 of 2025, with the following conditions:-

(I) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and on his/her absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his/her bail bond shall be cancelled by the Court below.

(II) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the



witnesses, in that case, the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.

(III) And, further condition that the court below shall verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and in case at any stage, it is found that the petitioner has concealed his criminal antecedent, the court below shall take step for cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner. However, the acceptance of bail bonds in terms of the above-mentioned order shall not be delayed for purpose of or in the name of verification.
