3 12-02-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel appearing on behalf of
the informant.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 103(2), 61(2) and 3(5) of the
B.N.S. and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

3. The prosecution case, in brief, is that four unknown
persons, riding on two motorcycles, shot brother of informant
due to which he died.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence.
Petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.. Name of petitioner
transpired in this case during course of investigation merely on



the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Md. Imran. Save and except confessional statement, there is no other material on record to show the complicity of this petitioner in the alleged occurrence. Till date, petitioner has not been put on test identification parade. Moreover, charge-sheet has already been submitted and petitioner, having no criminal antecedents, is in custody since 01.07.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the informant have vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, period of custody and clean antecedents of the petitioner, the prayer for grant bail of to the petitioner is allowed.

7. Accordingly, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-XII, Nalanda at Biharsharif in connection with Nalanda P.S. Case No. 87 of 2025.
