2. This is the second attempt on behalf of the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with Jaynagar P.S.Case No. 324 of 2024 registered for the offence punishable under Section 109,118(1),3(5) of the BNS and section 27 of the Arms Act.

3. Earlier the bail application of the petitioner has been rejected vide order dated 14.05.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No.28460 of 2025, which reads as under:-

*2. The applilcation is for grant
of r egular bail in connection with
Jaynagar P.S.Case No. 324 of 2024,
registered for the offence under section*



109,118(1) and 3(5) of the Bharitya Nyaya Sanhita and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the F.I.R, named and unnamed criminals shot at the victim. Petitioner is one of the accused who had reached the spot and tried to kill the victim.

4. The petitioner is in custody since 28.01.2025 and he has 12 criminal antecedents.

5. Considering the criminal antecedents of the petitioner, I am not inclined to extend the privilege of bail to the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, this application is dismissed.”

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the charge has been framed.

5. Considering the gravity of the offence and the fact that the trial has started, I am not inclined to review my earlier order.

6. Accordingly, the application stands dismissed.

7. The learned trial court is directed to expedite the trial at the earliest.
