2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Patahi P.S. Case No. 201 of 2025 registered for the offence under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S.

3. As per the prosecution case, petitioner is accused of assaulting the victim by knife.

4. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner has clean antecedent.

5. Learned counsel for the informant submits that



the parties have settled their dispute.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

7. Considering the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties and the fact that the parties have settled their dispute, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the concerned Court below within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M., Sadar Motihari, East Champaran/ concerned Court below in connection with Patahi P.S. Case No. 201 of 2025, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 / Section 482 of the BNSS.
