3 19-03-2026 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his
arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 126(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 303(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and the
informant alleges that while he was going back home when he
was surrounded by the accused persons including the petitioner
and was assaulted. It is next submitted that from perusal of the
allegation as alleged in the FIR, it would manifest that
allegation of assault is general and omnibus in nature i.e. no
specific allegation of assault is alleged against the petitioner. It
is also submitted that even the injury suffered by the injured has



been opined to be simple in nature. It is next submitted that Office Kumar @ Afice Kumar @ Opira Kumar had approached this Court seeking anticipatory bail by filing Cr. Misc. No.6239 of 2026 and the same came to be allowed by an order dated 04.02.2026 by a learned Coordinate Bench.

4. Learned A.P.P. opposes the anticipatory bail application.

5. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner, above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks, is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail-bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Narhat P. S. Case No.225 of 2025, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S.

6. The application stands allowed.
