2. This petition has been filed for quashing of the
F.I.R. bearing Chanpatiya P.S. Case No. 372 of 2018 dated
03.09.2018 registered under Section 420 of the Indian Penal
Code and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.



3. *Vide* order dated 02.04.2026, a report regarding present status of case was called for and the same was sent *vide* Letter No. 49/2026 dated 07.04.2026 by the learned Trial Court.
