2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in the present case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 25(1-b)a/ 26 of the Arms Act.

3. The recovery is of one country-made pistol and one cartridge from the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. Learned counsel further submits that petitioner has one criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 04.11.2025. The petitioner undertakes to co-operate in the case/ trial.

5. Learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner.



6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this application for regular bail is allowed.

7. Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the concerned Court below in connection with Danapur P.S. Case No. 1159 of 2025.

8. As a condition of this order, the petitioner after being released on bail, is directed to mark his attendance at Danapur Police Station, District- Patna on every Sunday of the month. Any default in appearance at the Police Station will result in cancellation of bail bonds of the petitioner.
