4 23-06-2026 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
APP for the State and the learned counsel for the informant.

2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Khaira P.S. Case No. 360 of 2021 registered for the offence
under Section(s) 147,149, 341, 323, 324,307, 504 of the Indian
Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner is
accused of assaulting the victim causing injury.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence.
Petitioner is in custody since 07.10.2025. It is also submitted
that the FIR has been registered after two months.



5. Learned A.P.P. for the State and the learned counsel for the informant have vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and the period of custody, this application for regular bail is allowed.

7. Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Khaira P.S. Case No. 360 of 2021.

8. It is made clear that any observation made herein is *prima facie* in nature and limited solely for the purpose of adjudication of the present bail application. Such observations shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and shall not influence the trial or any other proceedings in any manner.
