A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel for the informant.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118, 303(2), 109, 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita.

3. As per F.I.R., on 31.08.2025 at about 2:20 PM, the informant along with his father was returning on motorcycle, in the meantime, the accused persons named in the F.I.R. including these two petitioners surrounded them and assaulted. Petitioner no. 1 is alleged to have assaulted on the face of informant's father by means of iron rod, whereas petitioner no. 2 assaulted on his (informant's father) head by Dabiya. Doctor has found



the injuries simple in nature. Petitioner no. 1 claims clean antecedent, whereas petitioner no. 2 has got one criminal antecedent, in which, he is on bail.

4. Considering the nature of accusation and injury, let the above named petitioners, in the event of their arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Samastipur in connection with Khanpur P.S. Case No. 210 of 2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
