2 28-01-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Garhi P.S. Case No. 99 of 2025 registered for the offence under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 324(4), 329(3), 351(2), 352/3(5) of the BNS.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioners are alleged to have assaulted the victim.

4. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are innocent and they have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that from the impugned order, it will appear that the injury cause to



the alleged victim is simple in nature.

5. Considering the aforesaid facts, this application is allowed.

6. Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the concerned Court below within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jamui/concerned Court below in connection with Garhi P.S. Case No. 99 of 2025, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 / Section 482 of the BNSS.
