ORAL ORDER

2 12-01-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Ballia
P.S. Case No. 430 of 2025, instituted for the offences punishable
under Section 111 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, read
with Sections 30(a) and 41(1) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that 105 liters
liquor, two motorcycles and other articles have been recovered.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
present case. No incriminating material has been recovered from
the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has got



no concern with the alleged recovery of liquor. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that the petitioner was not arrested on spot. Name of the petitioner has transpired as being owner of one of the motorcycle in question which was parked by the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 01.12.2025 and has got no criminal antecedent. There is no compliance of Section 103 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Ballia P.S. Case No. 430 of 2025.
