A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 329(4), 110, 352 of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita.

3. As per F.I.R., these two petitioners are alleged to have assaulted on the head of informant, but doctor has found only one injury, which itself contradicts the prosecution case. Petitioners claim clean antecedent.

4. Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.

5. In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the



above named petitioners, in the event of their arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Mohania (Kaimur) in connection with Durgawati P.S. Case No. 342 of 2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
