ORAL ORDER

2 19-01-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Luakaha
P.S. Case No. 174 of 2025 instituted for the offences punishable
under Sections 274, 275, 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita,
2023 and 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act as also
25(1-b)a, 26, 35 of the Arms Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that total 72 litres
of liquor was recovered from motorcycle. It is further alleged
that there is recovery of one pistol and two live cartridges from
the co-accused.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the
petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. No



incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. He further submitted that the recovery of arms and ammunitions has been made from the co-accused. Learned counsel further submitted that petitioner is in no manner connected with the vehicle in question or the alleged recovery of liquor and arms. The petitioner is in custody since 28.10.2025 and has no criminal antecedent. There is no compliance of Section 103 of the Bharatiya Nagarika Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as also the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Luakaha P.S. Case No. 174 of 2025.
