ORAL ORDER

7 03-07-2026 Learned counsel for the Tilka Manjhi Bhagalpur University submits that the claim of the petitioner has already been allowed vide order dated 28.06.2026, as contained in Memo No. Legal-32/2021/178-179, which has been appended to the show cause filed on behalf of O.P. Nos. 1 to 3. It is, therefore, submitted that nothing survives for adjudication in the present writ application.
