A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2) & 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita.

3. As per F.I.R., on a trivial issue, a free fight took place between the parties, in which both sides sustained injury. Case and counter case. This petitioner is alleged to have assaulted on the head of nephew of informant with iron rod. Doctor has found the injury simple in nature.

4. Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

5. Considering the nature of injury, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, let



the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jamui in connection with Lachhuar P.S. Case No. 133 of 2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482 of the B.N.S.S., 2023.
