- 2 22-01-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.
2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.
3. As per F.I.R., enraged by the intervention of the father of informant, this petitioner is alleged to have assaulted informant with *dab*, upon his head.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that both parties are agnates and due to family feud, altercation took place in which both sides sustained injuries. Case and counter case.
5. Learned A.P.P. for the State vehemently opposed the bail application.
6. Considering the relation between the parties and nature of accusation, this anticipatory bail is allowed and it is



ordered that let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saran at Chapra in connection with Sonpur P. S. Case No. 677 of 2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
