ORAL ORDER

2 22-01-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 190, 191(2), 115(2), 126(2), 109, 303(2), 352 and 351(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.

3. As per F.I.R., all the named accused persons, including this petitioner, along with 5-6 unknown persons abused and assaulted informant and her husband and took Rs. 25,000/-, gold *Hanumani* and mobile phone from possession of the husband of informant.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. Allegation of assault is general and omnibus and there is no specific allegation of any overt act against petitioner. Rest of the



allegations are ornamental only to make the case grave.
Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State vehemently opposed the bail application.

6. Considering backdrop of the case, nature of accusation and clean antecedent, this anticipatory bail is allowed and it is ordered that let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of District & Additional Sessions Judge-II, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Banjariya P. S. Case No. 64 of 2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
