3 24-07-2026 The present petition has been filed for restoring a petition bearing MJC No. 884 of 2024, which has stood dismissed on account of non-compliance of the peremptory order dated 16.05.2025.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on account of the laxity of the Advocate clerk, the defects, as pointed by the registry, could not be removed within time, hence a sympathetic view be taken and the aforesaid petition be restored to its original file.
