APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Chhauradano P.S. Case No. 142 of 2024 for the offences
registered under Sections 467, 468, 470, 471, 420 of the I.P.C.

3. As per the prosecution case, earlier on the basis of
the document mutation in the name of the petitioner was
rejected, however, he changed the document number and re-
applied with the new letter to escape detection by the
departmental software.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case. Mutation of the petitioner's land on the document was



done and is still subsisting. Petitioner re-applied fresh petition for mutation and there is no illegality in filing fresh mutation petition. Petitioner is a farmer having one criminal antecedent. After completion of investigation charge-sheet has already been submitted. There is no chance of absconding the petitioner or tampering with the evidence. Petitioner is in custody since 12.10.2025. He undertakes to co-operate in the trial.

5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State opposes the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the submissions made on behalf of the parties, facts and circumstances of the case, charge-sheet has already been submitted and also period of custody undergone by the petitioner, let the petitioner, named above, be enlarged on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M. 1st Class, Raxaul at Motihari in connection with Chhauradano P.S. Case No. 142 of 2024.
