Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submit that the petitionershave been falsely implicated in connection with the statement of co-accused and are in custody for 252 days. As such on a stringent condition, petitioners pray for bail.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that the subject matter of the case relates to recovery of 255 Kgs. of cannabis.However, a part of the contraband was recovered from the possession of the present petitioners being 22.1 Kgs.

Having considered the quantum of the seizure in this particular case and the fact that charges have already been framed, at this stage,I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.The petitioners would renew their prayer for bail after evidence of the seizure witnesses are over.

At this stage, the bail application being CRM(NDPS) 72 of 2026 is dismissed.
