PER, SUJOY PAUL, ACJ.:

1. Counsel for petitioner filed affidavit-of-service.

The singular prayer of petitioner is that the order dated 26.11.2025 passed by learned Tribunal in O.A. No.1251/2022 (Kolkata) shows that the matter is listed for hearing on 21st January, 2026. However, it is submitted that a sizeable number of dates of hearing were fixed but, no final hearing could actually take place. Thus, Tribunal may be directed to finally hear the matter on the next date and decide it in accordance with law.
