1. Heard the learned counsels for the parties.
2. Perused the case diary.
3. The prosecution case is that the petitioner/lady was having an affair with the victim. It is alleged that due to enormous pressure for money from her, the victim committed suicide.
4. It will be for the Courts to finally decide whether there is any element of abetment of suicide in this case.
5. However, considering the materials available in the case diary, I do not think that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required in this case and I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
6. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be

subject to further conditions that the petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation and shall not threaten or intimidate the witnesses.

7. Accordingly, the application for anticipatory bail is allowed.
