CRM (NDPS) 61 of 2026

In re : An Application for **Bail** under Section **439** of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023 in connection with **Hili PS Case No. 98 of 2025 dt. 06.05.2025 u/s 20(b)(ii)(A)/21(c)/22(c)/23(c)/27(A)/28 of the NDPS Act read with sections 27a/27(b)(ii)/27A of the Drugs and Cosmetic Act.**

Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for more than eight and half months and similarly placed accused persons have already been granted bail in connection with the instant case.

Having considered that the other accused person has been granted bail in CRM (NDPS) 94 of 2026 and the fact that charges have already been framed in connection with the instant case, inspite of the objection being raised by the State, I am of the view that further detention of the present petitioner is unwarranted.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **Allowed.**

Accordingly, the petitioner viz, Sanjit Roy shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-(Rupees

Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Learned Special Judge (under NDPS Act)-cum- Additional Sessions Judge, 3rd Court, Dakshin Dinajpur at Balurghat.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date so fixed by the learned Special court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of Dakshin Dinajpur without prior permission of the learned Special Court.

Accordingly, CRM(NDPS) 61 of 2026 is **allowed**.
