Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the petitioners failed to repay the money that was taken and was promised to be repaid after some time.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail. She submits that the principal accused used to take money from different people on the pretext of investing such money in shares. The present petitioners used to be present when these transactions took place and the petitioner no. 2 used to draw the agreements. Later on, the principal accused got himself admitted in a rehab centre.

Considering the above, the other materials available in the case diary, the alleged roles ascribed to the present petitioners, I do not think that custodial interrogation of the petitioners is required in this case and I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023 and on further condition that the petitioners shall cooperate with investigation, shall not threaten or intimidate witnesses and the petitioner no. 1 shall meet the I.O. once a fortnight till submission of report in final form.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
